


What are the alternative solutions of green transformations for economic growth and employment with respect of nature and society?

Yet, governments deny the rights of citizens to participate in the decision-making process in the planning of these projects which have substantial consequences in peoples’ lives.



Nowadays, the technocratic “developmentalist” agenda and the lack of democracy go hand in hand. But it has been widely documented that the economic growth cannot be sustained in the absence of democracy.
